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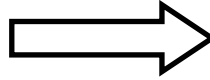

As notified, January 1 is when your new rent amounts go into effect. There was a small decrease in the amount of the Tax Pass-On so you should all decrease your payments by \$1.06. If you are unsure what amount you should pay, please give us a call for the correct amount. For those who pay rent via EFT or automatically through the Resident Portal, there is nothing you need to do, the correct amount will be deducted from your account accordingly.

Speaking of EFT, for those who still pay rent via checks, please consider paying via EFT or automatically through the resident portal [www.communityresport.com](http://www.communityresport.com). By doing so, you don't have to worry about if your rent is paid and your personal information is so much safer. If you would like to sign up and need assistance, Nena and I will be more than happy to assist you.

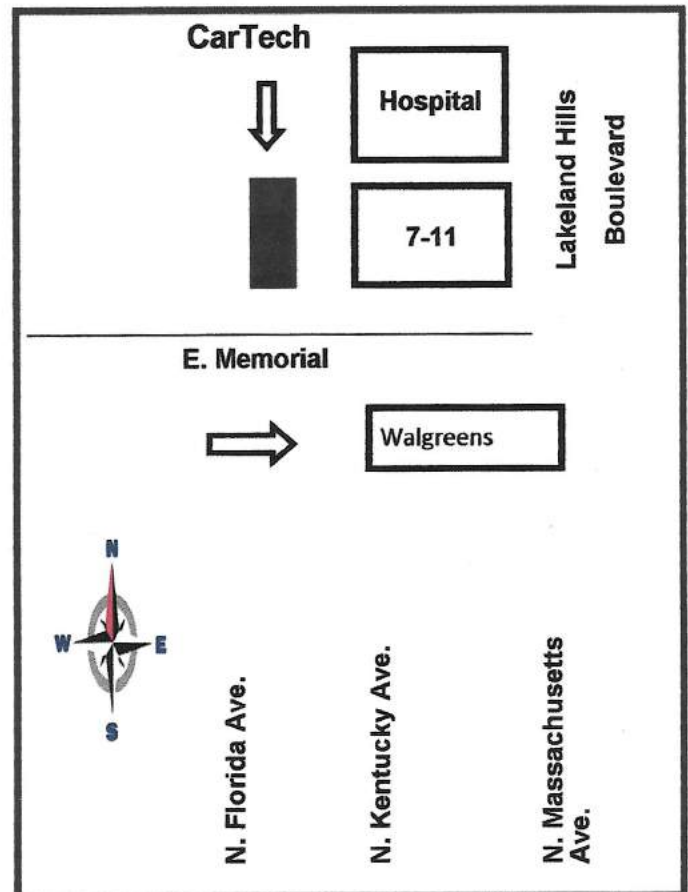

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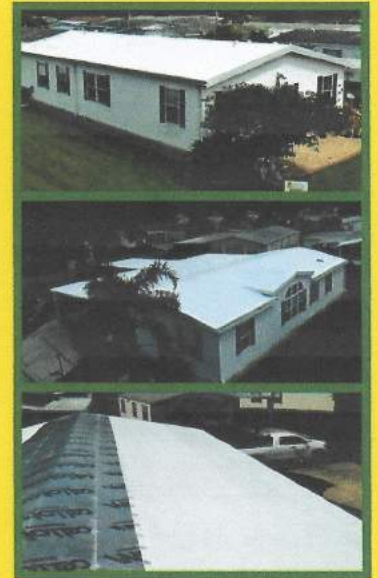
