Happy Summer everyone! Hard to believe that summer is on the downside already, but that means all our snowbird friends will soon be returning! Hopefully those of you who remain in the park over the summer have seen the projects that have been completed (those of us who are not there might have seen pictures on Facebook, I know I did). The pool and spa area look fantastic, the Veterans Memorial Garden is beautiful, and the golf cart parking lot has been expanded and has room for many more carts. Thanks to the park office staff and residents who played any part in getting these projects completed. I am sure we all appreciate these changes to the park.

The Homeowners Committee had a meeting with Jamie and ELS on May 21 2024. Discussion during that meeting included (but is not limited to) 360° inspections not completed timely, the need to pave more than one or two streets a year and prioritize what streets should be resurfaced next due to flooding, catch basin being in ill-repair, and why it takes so long before (years) before ELS addresses issues that are brought to their attention. The minutes from that meeting will be posted on the Lakeland Harbor Homeowners Association website page by the end of the first full week of August (I apologize for the delay in getting the minutes typed up).

I spoke with Jamie recently about the home inspections and road paving. She explained that she has been addressing houses that are visibly in need of attention and those owners are getting notifications and follow-up requirements. Her plan is to inspect ¼ of the homes every quarter so that everyone will have an inspection once a year. Regarding the street paving, she shared that ELS is developing a plan and schedule for this year's paving and will let us know when that plan has been developed and what the plan is.

With the first half of the year behind us, so are half of our approved social events. I want to thank Deanna Houck for stepping into the Social Committee Chairperson role. She has big shoes to fill after Linda Thacker resigned, but I think she is doing a great job so far. We have a Luau planned for August 17<sup>th</sup>. We are hoping many of you that attended the party for the reopening of the pool will also attend the luau. More information on that event can be found in this newsletter. Deanna will also have a list of upcoming events, some of which need a chairperson. Please look over the list and consider getting a team together and chairing an event. We can't hold events if we don't have help, so thank you in advance for stepping up.

Finally, Jeff and I will be back in the park on Tuesday July 30<sup>th</sup> and look forward to seeing all our friends again. We missed you!

- Shower before entering the water
- No Smoking in the pool or the fenced pool area
- Close the umbrellas before you leave

Take your personal belongings with you when you leave the pool area

Please remember we are now in Hurricane Season. The latest Disaster packets are available in the office, please come by and pick one of those up. Also take this time to start preparing your homes and sites for if we have a storm, there is nothing worse than having to rush at the last minute.

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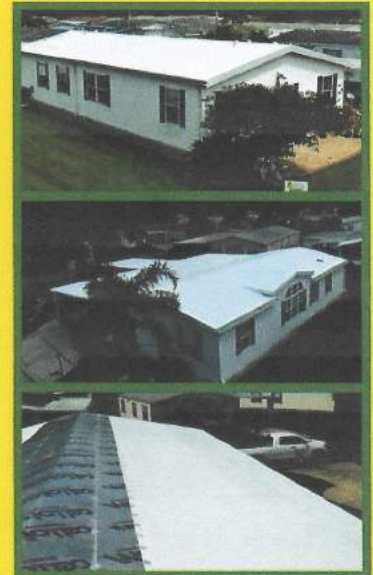
