If you are interested, you must submit the paperwork to Linda Oman, our Election Committee Chairman, by August 30. The paperwork can be found by clicking the Candidate Nomination Required Forms link on the **lakelandharborhomeowners.org** website, or by contacting Linda. There is a section in this Harbor Light that explains what you must do, if you are interested. I hope that some of you would agree to serve, and I encourage you to give it a try.

Another reminder about our Veterans' Wall in the Clubhouse. Please let me know if you are a Veteran and your name is not on the wall; it is our goal that the names listed include all our Veterans. We will use that list to invite our veterans to our annual Veterans' Day Luncheon in November.

Looking forward to the return of some of our great activities between now and the end of the year. I understand that we are still looking for people to chair some of our events that will take place later in the year. If you would be willing to help, please contact Deanna Houck or Linda Schwartz. 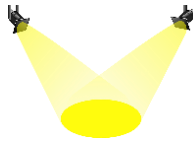

DOGS ON DECK

Because of the Dog Days of Summer, we want to give our WONDERFUL grill guys, Jeff and Tom, a break from the heat. In order to do this, we will be serving a revised menu during August as follows:

SIT AND BE FIT

Vacation's over! SIT AND BE FIT will begin again on Wednesday, Sept. 2nd and Thursday, Sept. 3rd and on every following Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday throughout the month at 9:30 AM.

Not a cardio or bulk-up program. Just easy stretches - while you stay seated. Optional: bring a light stretch band, a 9" playground ball, and a 1/2 inch ball. Exercises can be done without the optional items.

LAKELAND HARBOR ADOPT-A-SCHOOL PROGRAM

During a visit to a local elementary school, I was inquiring if they had a senior volunteer program where grandmas and grandpas go to the schools and read to the students or assist wherever necessary. While I was standing at the door waiting to be approved for entrance, a school bus was offloading a bunch of kids. One of the kids only had a pair of brown socks on his feet - he had no shoes. I asked to speak to the Principal and the Social Worker and from that meeting our Lakeland Harbor Adopt-a-School program was born.

Lakeland Harbor has participated in the Adopt-a-School program since March. Our school is North Lakeland Elementary on Robson. There are 550 students - 98% live at or below the poverty level and 59 of them are homeless. 78 of the students receive a Kidspack of weekend food.

Since March, the Busy Fingers craft group and other concerned residents have supplied the school with 66 pairs of shoes/socks, 200+ pop-top cans of ready-to-eat meals, 150 pouches of juice, 200 individual pudding and Jello cups, and hundreds of individual snack packs of cookies and crackers.

In July, the social worker identified their greatest need was for uniforms. We held a mini-fundraiser and were able to purchase 44 uniform shirts, 32 pairs of uniform shorts, 2 cardigans, and 1 skirt.

We will post other items that the Principal and the Social Worker have identified as "critical need" and their specific requirements on the bulletin board and in future issues of the Harbor Light newsletter.
