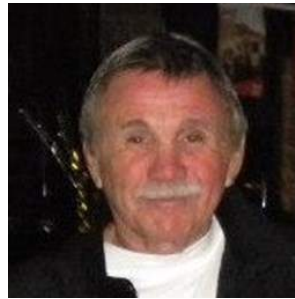

Hello Lakeland Harbor! Welcome Home many of our snowbird residents that have already come back. Yay cooler weather! This past week or so has been a nice change from the heat we experienced this summer.

Just a reminder of the new Produce Market that will be in the clubhouse every 1st & 3rd Saturday of the month from 11am – 1pm. I hope everyone is as excited about this as I am.

I hope this is the last managers message that I must talk about Electronic Payments. We have done a fantastic job getting the majority of our residents enrolled. If you still have not switched from paying rent via checks, money order, or bill pay (which is still having a check mailed), you are officially past the deadline. Please call or visit the office to set up your electronic payments.

Next, I will be starting Exterior 360 Inspections in the near future. This means we will be inspecting the exterior of all 4 sides of your home and site. We have beautiful, well-manicured homes in our community, so I am sure to be passing out a lot of "Awesomeness Certificates". So, everyone knows what we are looking at when we do these, we are following the Prospectus & Rules and Regulations. If you do not have a copy and would like one, please come get one in the office. We are looking at the overall appearance and cleanliness of your home and site. Some of the things you could be asked to do (but are not limited to) are pressure wash (home and/or concrete), repaint (home, trim, concrete, etc.), weed, trim landscaping, remove items improperly stored on carport or around home, removal of prohibited items, clean out gutters. Let's have so many "Awesomeness Certificates" that I run out of smiley face stickers.

With that being said, please make sure you are getting your approvals. Exterior Modification Forms are required when making any changes to the exterior appearance of your home or site. If you are unsure, please reach out to the office. Additionally, some changes will require permits from the City, also clarify with them.

With all our snowbird residents returning home and the holidays approaching, please keep a few things in mind. There is no parking in the grass and there is no overnight parking in the street. Please plan ahead and receive a Parking Permit for guests to park at the clubhouse.

Lastly, we are a very pet friendly community, however we are still having issues with pet owners walking their pet in other resident's sites, not picking up pet waste, not keeping their pet on a leash, or leaving their pet unattended outside. Please be respectful of your neighbors and follow the rules.

Recipe of the Month—Sour Cream Apple Pie

**2 eggs, 1C, sour cream, 1 C. sugar, 6 T. all-purpose flour divided, 1 t. vanilla extract, ¼ t. salt
3 C. chopped peeled cooking apples, 1 unbaked pie shell (9 inches), 3 T butter or margarine melted., ¼ C. packed brown sugar.**

In a large bowl, beat eggs, add sour cream, stir in sugar, 2T flour, vanilla, and salt, mix well. Stir in apples. Pour into pie shell. Bake @ 375 for 15 minutes. Meanwhile, combine butter, brown sugar, and remaining flour. Sprinkle over top of pie. Return to oven for 20-25 minutes or until filling is set. Cool completely on a wire rack. Serve or cover and refrigerate.

Serve with vanilla ice cream or with whipped topping.

(Remember, I'm always in the market for EZ recipes.)

Submit a short article that can be published in this newsletter to share with your neighbors. Maybe you can help them avoid the same pitfalls or just let them have a bit of a chuckle.

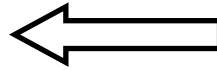
Hopefully they will laugh *WITH* you as they read your article.

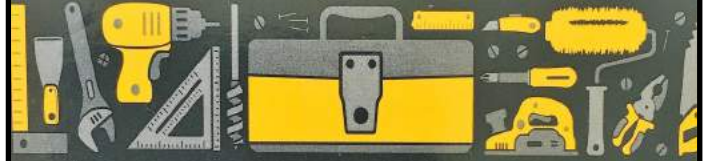

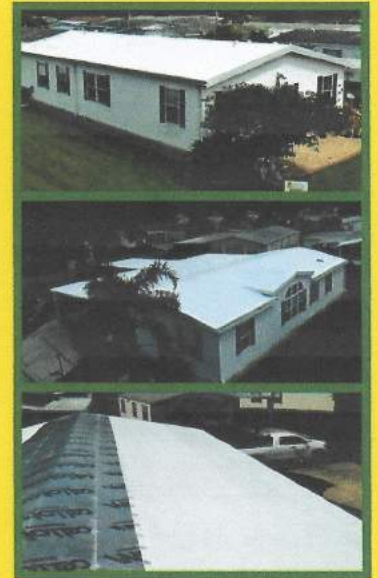
