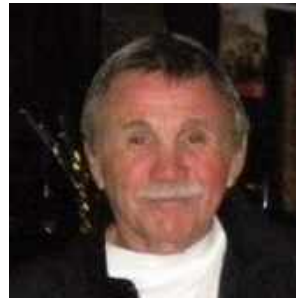

MANAGER'S MESSAGE

Hello Lakeland Harbor! I am glad to report Hurricane Idalia did not leave her mark on us here and we made it through without any damage or heavy debris. I am also happy to say the clubhouse roof has been replaced and we are very appreciative of those workers for all their hard work.

I love it when I can start out with so much good news! Lakeland Harbor is excited to announce that we have a new Administrative Assistant, JoAnn. She is fantastic! If you have not had a chance to meet her or speak with her on the phone, please call or come by and help me in welcoming her to Lakeland Harbor.

Everyone should have received their notice by now that effective October 1, 2023, ELS is moving towards an all-electronic rent collection process. For those who still have not switched from paying rent via checks, money order, or bill pay (which is still having a check mailed), please call or visit the office to set up your electronic payments. Again we offer a couple of different methods, EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer) which is a form in the office with a voided check or ACH document from your bank; or the Resident Portal which allows the resident to create their user ID and password to manage their own banking information, www.communityresport.com/ELS. For those residents that use money orders there is also an electronic option through Western Union. I have heard from several of you already that will come by the office once you have returned to the community for the winter and that is perfect, we look forward to seeing you. If you would like more information or need to sign up, I will be more than happy to assist you.

Next, by the time you are reading this the rent increase letters will have already gone out in the mail. I want to take this opportunity to ask each of you to not only review the rent amounts, but also the names listed at the top of the letter. The names that are listed indicate who is a leaseholder for your site. With a very small exception, everyone living in your home should be a leaseholder. Please check those names for accuracy; spelling, should they be included, or is someone missing. I have spoken with several residents since coming to Lakeland Harbor and I believe there has been some misinformation shared with you in the past about keeping your account and more importantly your lease up to date. Some corrections are as simple as providing a death certificate, marriage certificate, or divorce decree. Some may require someone to complete a residency application. But with almost all situations, now there are always exceptions, however we can make these updates without changing your current site rent. In fact, making these changes ahead of something happening is how we can ensure your site rent does not go to market rates for your family in the future. Please reach out to me if you have a question or need to make corrections.

Lastly, there are posted speed limit signs throughout the community stating the limit is 15 MPH. We have a lot of residents that enjoy walking or riding their bikes through the community, and they should feel safe doing so. Please be respectful of your neighbors and follow the rules.

Thank you all for everything you do to make our community a beautiful and welcoming place.

Recipe of the Month Lemon Pretzel Dessert

2 ½ C pretzels, crushed, 2 t vanilla, 2/3 C brown sugar, 2 T flour, ½ C butter, melted, 8 Oz, cream cheese, room temp., 1C powdered sugar, 8 Oz. cool whip, 22 Oz can of lemon pie filling Preheat oven to 375, crush pretzels(save some for garnish) , add vanilla, brown sugar, and flour. Stir until combined. Melt butter and add to pretzel mixture Mix well. Spread pretzel mix into a 13x9 baking dish and press mixture into smooth layer, bake for 10 min. and cool completely. Beat cream cheese until smooth, add powdered sugar, beat well then add cool whip and mix to combine. Spread over cooled crust, top with lemon pie filling, spread evenly, Sprinkle remaining crushed pretzel over mixture. Cover and refrigerate for 4 hours or overnight.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. Your participation is important to reach a quorum.

NOTE:

We will make every effort to schedule the mailing of absentee/proxy packages when requested. Completed packages must be received by the Election Committee at least 24 hours prior to the Annual Meeting.

If you will be in Lakeland Harbor but unable to attend the meeting, you may still request an absentee/proxy package. It will be delivered and, if necessary, picked up once completed. This also must be completed at least 24 hours prior to the Annual Meeting.

NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION COMMITTEE

At the Annual Meeting LHHA members will vote for candidates for the Board of Directors, the 2024 Budget and any proposed revisions to the LHHA Bylaws. Information on this is included in this newsletter, will be in the November edition and is also available on our website www.lakelandharborhomeowners.org

At the October 12th Board of Directors meeting candidates can also be nominated from the floor. The timing of this is required by Florida State Statute 723 which calls for such nominations to take place 27 days prior to the election at the Annual Meeting which is on November 9th.

To nominate someone in October, both the person making the nomination and the individual being nominated must be present at that meeting to make and accept the nomination. Following that the nominee must immediately complete the same paperwork that the other candidates submitted during August. Both the person making the nomination and the nominee must be members in good standing of LHHA. A complete list of candidates is then submitted via this Committee to the full Board at the close of the meeting.

Remember, we must have a quorum present at the Annual Meeting in November in order to accomplish this goal. Please plan on attending. If you will not be in Lakeland Harbor at that time, or if there are other circumstances that prevent you from attending that evening, you may request an absentee ballot and proxy. The proxy counts toward achieving the quorum and your vote on the absentee ballot can only be counted with all paperwork being properly completed and received by the Board Secretary with a deadline which is no later than 24 hours before the Annual Meeting.

If you know that you will not be able to attend the Annual Meeting, you may contact us now and we will add your name to the list of those who will be sent the package of information for casting your absentee ballot.

SOME NOTES REGARDING WHAT YOU WILL BE VOTING ON NEXT MONTH:

The Candidates for the Board of Directors volunteer to serve the residents and are elected at large. Currently our Board calls for seven Directors, with four (4) elected one year and three (3) the next year. This year is the year with three (3) positions open.

The 2024 Budget is prepared by the Budget Committee, reviewed by the Board of Directors and then voted on by the Membership of LHHA.

The Vice President serves on the Bylaws Committee who considers any revisions that may be proposed. If there are revisions in a given year, the Committee forwards them to the Board of Directors who would vote to move them forward to the Membership for a vote when required.
