MANAGER'S MESSAGE

First and foremost, on behalf of myself and staff; please accept our heartfelt THANK YOU for your cooperation and understanding as we continue to navigate the various phases of re-opening our amenities, specifically our pool.

There were many challenges to overcome before the pool could re-open. The most important of all is the well-being and safety of you residents. The biggest challenge of all; acquiring the various products needed for cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing. Next, adjusting our small staff schedule to do the required cleaning and sanitizing every few hours; even on the weekend (when we usually are off spending time with our families and loved ones). No matter what your beliefs are in regard to the COVID-19 pandemic, unfortunately it has changed the dynamics of our daily "norm" and affects all of us in some way, shape or form. I choose the "take one day at a time" approach, it has helped me get through some really rough and stressful days. 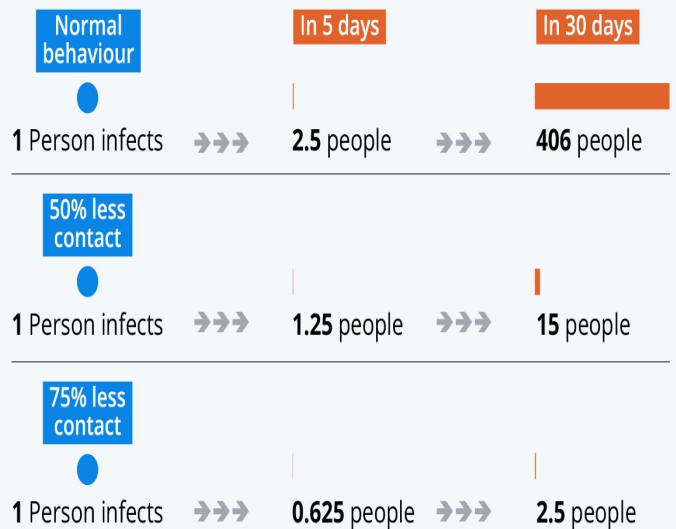

Stir together condensed milk and next four ingredients until well blended, pour over crust. Bake @ 350 for 25 minutes until golden. Cool and cut into squares. Enjoy!
