I hope that everyone who is spending the summer at Lakeland Harbor is finding a way to stay cool during these hot days. Hopefully you are taking advantage of the pool and spending some time in the water. For our residents who have chosen to leave Florida for some cooler weather, I hope that you are enjoying your time away from the heat.

We submitted our 2024 CapEx requests in early June. We asked to have the porthole door in the back of the Clubhouse and one of the side doors leading to the pool deck area be made handicap accessible by adding a push button that can be used to enter or leave the Clubhouse using those doors. We also asked that a threshold ramp be installed at that the porthole door.

We asked for the lever used to leave and/or enter the pool area closest to the bathrooms be lowered so that those using wheelchairs and walkers can easily reach it.

We asked to have the pool be resurfaced and the golf cart parking area near the mailboxes be leveled off.

We proposed adding a pickleball court, however, there really is no place to put the court with the available space that we have.

We also asked for the road paving project to be continued.

These have not been approved by ELS yet, but we are hopeful that they will be.

I have been informed that the clubhouse roof replacement and the push button added to one of the main doors of the Clubhouse will be completed. These are leftover items from last year.

The new phone directory will be going to print sometime in August. We need to submit our information to the publisher very soon. Many of you have contacted the office, Linda Schwartz or me asking to have your information updated. We have made those updates. If anyone still wants to update their information, please contact me immediately to let me know. Once our information is submitted to the publisher it will be impossible to change.

Hi Lakeland Harbor. I hope everyone is well and staying cool these past few very warm months. We have been busy here in Lakeland Harbor getting the sprinkler system working and enhancing our curb appeal with fresh landscaping. We are still waiting for the clubhouse roof to be replaced but are hopeful that work will begin soon.

As some of you might have heard our Administrative Assistant, Nena, has transferred to another property to continue her growth with ELS. Please be patient with me as I am looking to fill her position.

I have a few items I'd like to mention:

First off, just a reminder regarding our pets, they need to be on a leash at all times when outside of your home. They also cannot be tied up outside on your home site. Please be respectful of your neighbors' site when walking your pet, you should not be on someone else's site. Each pet owner is responsible for picking up after their pet.

Next, ELS is moving towards an all-electronic rent collection process. For those who still pay rent via checks, money order, or bill pay (which is still having a check mailed), please consider visiting the office to set up your electronic payments. We offer a couple of different methods, EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer) which is a form in the office with a voided check or ACH document from your bank or the Resident Portal which allows the resident to create their user ID and password to manage their own banking information www.communityresport.com. For those residents that use money orders there is also an electronic option through Western Union. Using one of these options, eliminates the worry of your rent being paid/arriving on time and your personal information is more secure. If you would like more information or to sign up, I will be more than happy to assist you.

Lastly, as we are in the midst of summer and the rainy season everyone's grass and landscaping are growing beautifully. Seeing everything so green and colorful is wonderful, it makes our community very attractive. Just a reminder though each homeowner needs to make sure those items stay weed-eated, flowerbeds weeded and landscaping trimmed. If you live along the community fence line, please make sure your landscaping is trimmed off the fence.

FMO Members – Helped defeat sales tax on lot rents

Bylaws, Policy and Procedure Committee – Continues updating documents for the best member experiences

PAC Committee is rewriting bills for the House and Senate from 2023 efforts to our 2024 bills to change the authority in sections of Chapter 723 (related to maintenance and other requirements for both park owners and homeowners) from the Board of Registration process to the Office of the Florida Attorney General

Gentle Reminder: FMO is mindful of member costs and has cut magazine costs, improved options to increase advertisers while increasing benefits to members. The website is now full-service including legal easy advice process for members and HOAs

Member costs have had to adjust to \$30 annually from \$25, with 3 years to \$75 from \$65 effective August 14, 2023

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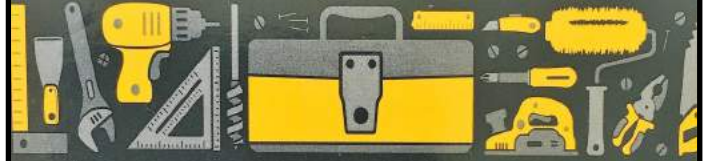

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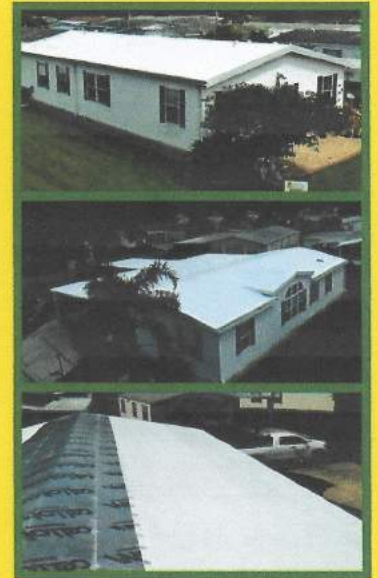
